

Extra marina berths to meet boating demand

THE popularity of boating on the Gold Coast has prompted a developer to release more marina berths at Hope Island.

Boaties will have a chance to secure one of 60 freehold berths at the Hope Island Marina when they are released on September 16.

Consolidated Properties is behind the project, and project partner Lachlan Grantley said the berths

would be in high demand. “The 2010 Queensland Marine Industry report shows that the Gold Coast

is the boating capital of the state,” he said.

“The city recorded the most registrations overall

and in each class for vessels without sails.

“Despite this title and the region’s popularity amongst boaties, there is an extremely constricted supply of marina berths.”

Mr Grantley said boat owners at Hope Island had easy access to deep water major canals, the Broadwater and ocean.

Consolidated sold its first parcel of 60 marina berths in 2007.
